


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# Attendance... (WE NEED YOUR HELP



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Good attendance means being in school at least 95% of the time (180 to 190 days)



96% - 96.9% = 34-46 lessons missed Approx. 220 hours of learning missed

94% - 95.9% = 46-68 lessons missed Approx. 275 hours of learning missed

90% - 93.9% = 68-114 lessons missed Approx. 550 hours of learning missed

Below 90% = At least 114 lessons missed Approx. 627 hours of learning missed

#### STONELODGE SCHOOL Develop your child's habit of reading



- Ensure they read for 20 minutes every night
- Watch a weekly documentary or TED talk together and discuss.
- Ask them about what they have read about during form time intervention lessons.
- Borrow books from the library... Please return them.
