What is LBC Week?

- A week where you take part in activities related to a 'Theme'.
- The activities are different to what you would normally do at school.
- The week incorporates a range of enrichment activities. Each theme will have a trip offsite.



Now and then Week (Year 8 and 9)

A trip to take you on a journey through the World War I battlefields. You will weave through the trenches, stand before the white crosses in the cemetery and explore the resilient town of Ypres. Students will go by ferry and coach for this trip.

Students will create a Stone Lodge memorial to the sacrifices of the World Wars, which will link to the experiences of local soldiers. It will be an immersive experience that not only informs but also forges a connection between the present and legacy of the past.

The plan for the week will be as follows:

Monday: Coach journey to Dover to catch the ferry to Calais and then drive to Ypres, Belgium to visit memorials.

Tuesday: Creating a display based on your experiences in school.

Wednesday: WWI talk with an expert on the period.

Thursday: Trip to Imperial War Museum.

Friday: WWI re-enactment.

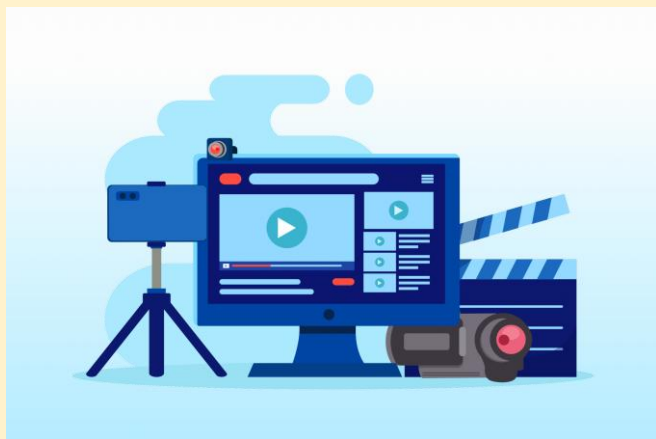

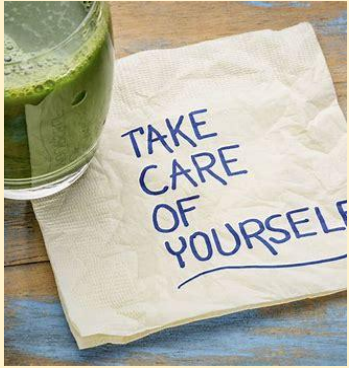

This year will also include a visiting guest bringing a few of his animal friends.

And the creativity doesn't stop there! You'll team up with your classmates to design and paint a spectacular mural of endangered species from around the world, with the hope of proudly displaying it in school.

Fashion Week

Begin your Fashion Week journey by choosing an exciting theme to inspire your design—whether you're drawn to bold colours, cultural influences, sustainability, streetwear, or futuristic fashion. Your theme will shape everything from your first sketch to your final outfit.

You'll kick-start the project with a visit to Greenwich Market, where you can explore unique patterns, textures, artwork, and independent designers. This creative environment will help spark ideas and guide your own fashion vision.

Back in school, you'll design and make your own piece of clothing. You'll develop ideas, sketch your design, select materials, and learn hands-on making skills to bring your outfit to life. No experience is needed—just creativity, enthusiasm, and a willingness to experiment. At the end of the project, your creation will be showcased in a full Fashion Week performance for the whole school. Students can get involved in every aspect of the show, including stage design, lighting, music and sound, backstage support, or even modelling their own outfit if they choose.

The week will include a trip to Greenwich market including budget to purchase items from charity shops.

A Taste of Europe

This five-day cross-curricular project introduces students to the rich cultural diversity of Europe through history, geography, languages, art, design, and food.

Students will explore how European countries have influenced one another over time and how culture is expressed through everyday life, creativity, and cuisine.

Throughout the week, students will take part in research activities, discussions, practical tasks, and a cultural visit to the Victoria and Albert Museum (V&A) in London. The project encourages teamwork, creativity, curiosity, and critical thinking, while helping students build an understanding of European identity and cultural heritage.

The week will end with a practical cooking session where students prepare and share selected European recipes, applying what they have learned about culture, design, and tradition.
